Home Risk Assessment

Front, Side and Back Yard

- OK NI House Numbers Are Easily Visible
- OK NI Bushes and shrubs pruned away from windows, doors and sidewalks
- OK NI Lighting covers all entrances and potential hiding places
- OK NI Driveway and Paths small gravel so that it crunches and makes noise when walked on
- OK NI Fence / gate secure where applicable

Doors

- OK NI Door is solid wood or metal clad
- OK NI Dead Bolt Lock
- OK NI Security Strike Plate
- OK NI Door Frame Secure
- OK NI Hinges and pins secure
- OK NI Molding tight and secure

Burglary Alarm Systems

- OK NI Monitored In-State
- OK NI Emergency Numbers by each phone

Valuable Identification

- OK NI Valuables Marked and Inventoried

Detached Buildings and Garage

- OK NI Locks on all doors and windows
- OK NI Lighting on all entrances
- OK NI Garage door closed and operating properly
- OK NI Garage door has internal lock

Windows

- OK NI Solid with original lock and in good repair
- OK NI Anti-lift device in place
- OK NI Glass is free of cracks and coated where Applicable

Sliding Glass Doors

- OK NI Original lock and in good repair
- OK NI Anti-slide device in place (wooden dowel)
- OK NI Anti-lift device (Screws in above slider)

Interior Lighting

- OK NI Automatic Timers for lights
- OK NI Automatic Timers for radios

Key Control

- OK NI Keep track of existing keys
(Have house re-keyed if keys are lost)
