This guide is to help our customers understand the types of materials we can collect through this service and their proper preparation for collection. We will not recycle materials other than those listed below. If materials other than those properly prepared and listed below are placed in your recycling container, they will be disposed of as trash even though in some areas they may be recycled.

Recyclable	Preparation	Examples	Not Collectible
Aluminum Cans	Empty	Beer and soda cans	Paper or bag beverage containers
Steel Cans	Empty and rinse out	Food and juice cans	Aerosol or paint cans
Glass Bottles & Containers	Empty and remove lids	Wine and beer bottles and food jars	Green or blue glass, ceramics, bulbs or plate glass
Newspapers, inserts, magazines, phone books, paperback books, junk mail, copier paper	Take bags off newspapers Remove the cover from paperback books	All paper items can be mixed together	Metallic paper Cardboard and paperboard. Cereal, shoe, frozen food, pizza boxes
#1 PETE Plastic Bottles (# is on the bottom)	Empty	Clear and green water or soda bottles	Oil or salad dressing bottles, cups, bowls, wrap
#2 HDPE Plastic Bottles (# is on the bottom)	Empty	Milk jugs, detergent bottles	Oil bottles, boxes, bags or tubs
